

INTERACTIVE BOOK READING	
Purpose	To provide a meaningful context for target words and definitions.
Objective	Child will use target words in spontaneous expressive language.
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Book • Questions on sticky notes • Target word cards visible to student • Highlight tape
Procedures	<p>Prepare the book for the Interactive Book Reading by writing a Competence, Abstract and Relate question on separate sticky notes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • COMPETENCE Question answers can be found in the text or pictures of the book. • ABSTRACT Questions require students to make inferences or predictions. • RELATE Questions connect students' experiences to the book. <p>Place the sticky note with the question on the corresponding page in the book.</p> <p>Optional: Highlight the vocabulary words that appear in the book.</p> <p>Before reading the book, review the words with the child and put the word cards where the child can see them during the book reading.</p> <p>Read the book.</p> <p>Stop and ask questions at the designated question pages (when you get to a sticky note).</p> <p>During reading, discuss the target vocabulary words and refer to the vocabulary picture cards. During discussion, use conversation strategies.</p> <p>Remember to keep the focus on the book reading.</p>
